Staff Spotlight: Kristin Ercoli, Hub Manager

When Kristin Ercoli first saw that KidsPlay was hiring a Hub Manager, she knew she had to apply. "It was basically my dream job," she says, recalling her excitement at the possibility of being a critical player in KidsPlay's new initiative, The Hub@KidsPlay*.

As a longtime KidsPlay member, Kristin discovered and often visited the Community Family Learning Center (CFLC) Resource Library, a collaborative project between KidsPlay and Torrington Public Schools since 2016.

"The CFLC introduced me to programs and resources that benefited my children," she says. Kristin began volunteering and later working in the resource library. "I really enjoyed being able to introduce others to programs that I have had positive experiences with."







As the Hub Manager, Kristin sees her new role as a way to meaningfully connect families with resources that will positively impact their wellbeing and outcomes for their children. "Many parents don't even know that help exists for them, and they're struggling when they don't need to be. Taking care of children is hard enough, and anything we can do to help them find support is really important."

The Hub@KidsPlay is a new space within the Museum's 57 Main Street expansion and a program initiative. The Hub provides a larger, more prominent location for the CFLC Resource Library and a new community program room. As a program initiative, it builds upon the museum's partnerships with Torrington Public Schools, and other early childhood stakeholders to improve access to a wide range of services, support, and information for families.
